PASTOR JEREMIAH'S MESSAGE

Luke 2:10-11. King James Version ... "And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people."

I look forward to the season of Advent every year. I find the autumn to be a time of extreme busyness; kids are back in school, many holidays to prepare for, yearly church conference, finishing up my garden harvest and preserving the food. The list goes on and on, and I find it wears on me sometimes. Yet every year I take renewed strength and hope from the stories of Advent: Mary's courage and her singing to God celebrating the world being turned upside down for the better in Jesus, the joy of the shepherds, the love and faith shown by Joseph, the journey of the Wise Men, and the music, the music, the music. Advent inspires me, as I remember that the world has already begun "to turn" as a contemporary carol the "Canticle of the Turning" put it. You will hear many carols, and some may be familiar, but listen to the words and see if some song, perhaps you've known since you were knee-

high, has something to say to you in a new way. Let us be open to how God offers us hope, peace, joy, and love this Advent and Christmas season, and may our hearts be warmed with a warmth and light we can share with others.


