PASTOR JEREMIAH'S MESSAGE

As we come to the end of August and into September, I often think about fruit. In my home garden the tomatoes are fruit, and as best I can tell the peppers, squash, and even cucumbers that continue to grow and produce are also technically fruit. I always think of apples this time of year and since moving to Malta, my thoughts turn to apples even more than before. So, in this season when we pick fruit, and so many plants are "bearing fruit" that is producing whether they are technically fruit or not, it's a good time to consider something from the writings of the Apostle Paul, the "Fruits of the Spirit" found in his letter to the Galatians in chapter 5.

These fruits of the Spirit, that is the Holy Spirit, were Paul's way of describing traits of a person who was following Christ in their lives. For most of the month of September we will be looking at these fruits and considering how God is leading us to live them out in our lives today. Paul listed 9 fruits, we shall only look at three: love, patience, and faithfulness. So join us as we think about how our lives can bear much fruit and bless others. And how, as we bear fruit, we can live into the blessings God intends for us all.



2021 ANNUAL NORTHERN ILLINOIS CONFERENCE UPDATE

More than 600 participated on Zoom in the 182nd session of the Northern IL. Conference with the theme: **"JESUS Makes A Way"** on July 16th and 17th, lead by Bishop John L. Hopkins. For the 2nd year, COVID-19 restricted an in-person meeting, making it necessary to meet virtually.

Bishop Hopkins focused on what he perceived as the Conference's strengths and challenges. We have gifted and dedicated clergy & laity and we take a strong stand for equity and justice with full inclusion of everyone. Our local churches are doing amazing frontline ministry. He spoke on the continual decline of apportionment payments and concern about Judisdictional realignment of conferences. He feels the Church needs to be unified and empowered. The Church needs to be clear about its mission - To make disciples: to love God with all our heart, and mind, and soul, and strength; and to love our neighbor as ourselves. We need to focus our attention on the people in our communities who need to know about the God we serve. The responsibility can not be given over to any one person, a committee or group. WE ARE ALL RESPONSIBLE!

BISHOP'S APPEAL OFFERING totaled more than \$25,000 and went toward the United Methodist Committee on Relief's COVID-19 relief efforts worldwide.


